



Absentee Voting in Wyoming

One of the most popular ways to vote in Wyoming is by absentee ballot. This important segment of the voting population now accounts for over 25% of all ballots cast. Over 90% of the voters who request a ballot return them.

In Wyoming, any qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot at any time during a calendar year in which the election is held, but not on the day of the election. Absentee voting in the State of Wyoming will begin **40 days** prior to an election and ballots will start being mailed by the County Clerks on that date.

Want to reach this important group of voters without having to call your County Clerk's office everyday?

Use AMBI Mail & Marketing's Absentee Ballot Program!

Here is how the program works:

AMBI receives a list of voters who have registered to vote by absentee ballot **every business day** from the Wyoming Secretary of State Office.

Early voters are **removed** from the voter list. The remaining names are then **household**ed to reduce the number of mailpieces to print and mail.

AMBI then filters the list for **your voting district** according to the specific criteria you have requested.

AMBI immediately mails your custom mailpiece (card, letter or flyer/brochure) to **your absentee voters** assuring they have your information as they ballot!
